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PRESENTATION

In 2017, AES Gener Foundation conducted various programs in the communes of Tocopilla, Mejillones, Huasco, Puchuncaví, Renca and San José de Maipo, all of them cities where AES Gener performs its productive activity.

In this sense, the main Social Responsibility of the Company is to generate safe and reliable energy that contributes to the development and progress of the country and its inhabitants, but we know that our commitment to our neighbors goes much further and seeks to contribute to improve their quality of life through the following three pillars: Education, Community-use Infrastructure, and Employability.

Most of the work that we do as AES Gener Foundation, is the result of a constructive and collaborative dialog that we developed together with local municipalities and with the representative organizations of neighbors. In this way, we validate the implementation of each of the programs and projects that are part of our portfolio, understanding that they do not respond to a biased view as a company, but that they are part of an actual benefit.

We believe that the success of the programs also lies in that each one of them has a strong local component, which seeks to enhance the characteristics of the communes where they are conducted, thus allowing either a contribution to the education of their children and young people, the opening of spaces to improve their quality of life, the improvement of infrastructure or installation of capacities to choose better career options.

The above reasons have led us to conclude that, beyond the three pillars we have established as the central axes of our work, we understand that the reality and interests of each one of the communes in which we are inserted is diverse and, therefore, we also develop initiatives in areas such as sports, oral health, culture and entertainment.

From the AES Gener Foundation and the Company, we shall keep on preparing the way that will lead us to continue to be a key player in the development and progress of the communities where we perform our operations.

History

The AES Gener Foundation is a non-profit institution, which was originally created in 1993 as “Maitenes Foundation”. Its purpose until that time has been to implement outdoor education programs to contribute to value formation and the integral development of children, young people and adults.

In 2008, the Foundation diversified its spheres of action and incorporated the development of leadership programs, team work, workshops and seminars for various areas and business units of AES Gener. It also works as a platform of the Company to administer, manage, and articulate social benefits established under the scope of the Corporate Local Community Relations Policy and other social agreements.

In July 2011, in order to position the work of Maitenes Foundation among the different stakeholders of the Company, the institution changed its name to AES Gener Foundation, thus consolidating its work in the three areas of action of the Social Responsibility Policy: education, employability and development of community-use infrastructure.

From that date, the institution has worked hard to increase and strengthen its program portfolio, which covers the communes of Mejillones and Tocopilla in the Antofagasta Region, Huasco in the Atacama Region, Puchuncaví in the Valparaíso Region, Renca and San José de Maipo in the Metropolitan Region.

To coordinate and undertake the initiatives and programs in terms of education and community relations developed by AES Gener in the locations where its business units are present, providing each of them with the values of the Foundation: sustainability, protection of the environment and safety.

EDUCATION AND TRAINING

MUNK PROGRAM

MunK Program has been implemented since 2011 in all the schools of Mejillones and Tocopilla.

In 2017, 1,623 students from 5th and 8th grade (plus a 4th grade that has been included as pilot) were benefited from this initiative, which provides boys and girls with an online platform of English language reinforcement, through animated stories and recreational activities. The program adopts the “edutainment” approach, which combines education and entertainment to stimulate the pleasure of learning in order to achieve better results.

During this year, the program was developed in 6 establishments in the commune of Tocopilla and in 2 establishments of Mejillones.

MunK is intended for students, teachers and guardians. Teachers monitor the progress of their students through online course and student reports. Based on these data, the classes can be adapted according to any areas causing greater group or individual difficulty.

In addition, each semester, the guardians will receive a report on the progress made by the students under their care.

To support the use of the platform, there are teachers who are specialists in its pedagogical use that will help the students to exploit its potential to the maximum. In addition, there are measurement tools that help to establish metrics on the level of knowledge and skills acquired by the students.

These standardized measurements of the knowledge level of English are supplemented by a survey carried out among students to obtain information on their study habits, which is also made at the beginning (pre-survey) and at the end (post-survey) of the activities during the year.

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS

PRE-UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIPS AND BEST PSU SCORES

In the last 7 years, AES Gener and the Municipality of Puchuncaví have been working together for the award of the Pre-University Scholarship. This program benefited 44 third- and fourth-year students of the Sargento Aldea secondary school of Las Ventanas and General Velásquez secondary schools of Puchuncaví during 2017.

With this contribution, we finance the studies of the best students of the educational establishments mentioned above so that they can prepare for the University Selection Test (PSU) at Pedro de Valdivia Preuniversity in Viña del Mar, where they are given educational tools to confront this challenge, and vocational guidance to improve the potential of the Commune's best students to gain access to higher education.

Two hundred and forty-one scholarships were granted from 2011 to 2017.

As an additional commitment adopted by the Company and the Municipality with the future professionals, AES Gener provides a cash prize, freely available and in one installment, to the three best PSU scores in the community.

Moreover, the municipality grants a computer to the students who have obtained the 4th, 5th and 6th place.

2017 "MOVILÍZATE CON LA BECA" (TRAVEL WITH THE SCHOLARSHIP) PROGRAM

For the sixth year, AES Gener is part of the group of companies that contributes to the mobilization of young people who are studying outside the commune of Puchuncaví. The benefit considers the monthly provision of \$ 25,000 (from March to December).

CONTRIBUTION TO ALTO MAIPO HIGHER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

For the fifth consecutive year, AES Gener Foundation granted the Scholarship Contribution to Alto Maipo Higher Education, which consists of a cash contribution for the benefit of those higher education students who reside in San José de Maipo and who have good academic performance and a deficient socio-economic situation.

The scholarship considers the delivery of \$800,000 per year for beneficiaries, which are freely available so that students can use it as they may deem appropriate to defray their education expenses.

The Scholarship Contribution to Alto Maipo Higher Education is part of the Social Agreement (which will be detailed below). As of 2017, 206 scholarships were granted, a figure that includes those students who have renewed the benefit.

In 2017, over 62 contributions were delivered, 40 of which are renewals and 22 are new beneficiaries. In total, the investment amount of this program is \$49,600,000.

Additionally, the Local Council of San José de Maipo decided to grant a contribution of \$150,000 to 13 scholarship students that obtained their diplomas in 2017. This monetary support is intended to recognize the completion of their academic cycles and to help them with the payment of their professional title.

LABOR SCHOLARSHIPS

In the communes of Tocopilla and Puchuncaví, AES Gener Foundation develops a scholarship program intended for neighbors between 18 and 65 years old who can access different courses to improve their employability conditions.

In the commune of Tocopilla, during 2017, we offered a Security Guard Course with the participation of 15 students and a Hairdressing Course with the participation of 20 students. These students, apart from having passed the course, have obtained a grant for tools that will enable them to practice their profession.

In the commune of Puchuncaví, 15 people participated in the Class B Driving Course, which was given by the Automobile Club of Chile, and Gestor MYPE.

In addition, 14 micro-entrepreneurs of Ventanas were trained and learned basic concepts for the management of businesses, including, without limitation, accounting, administration, marketing and commercialization.

TRAINING COURSES

SOCIAL MANAGERS

For the third consecutive year, in the commune of Puchuncaví, the Social Managers Program was implemented, which included subjects such as leadership, communication, organizational development and team work, among others.

Through theoretical and practical training, the program seeks that social leaders may exercise their social role with greater preparation and information and with a wishful and proactive thinking vis-a-vis their local realities.

In 2017, 20 social leaders mainly coming from sports, territorial and educational fields from different locations of Puchuncaví received this kind of training.

The program included 70 hours of workshops conducted in 7 months, which included subjects such as leadership, communication, organizational development, team work, community work, preparation of social projects and digital literacy.

We were able to observe that, as a result of the program, the trained leaders have improved significantly their performance and at least a 40% of them has managed to integrate themselves to social organizations of greater social representativeness at a community level. Fifty-two students were benefited between 2015 and 2017.

TRAINING PROGRAM IN SAN JOSÉ DE MAIPO

In order to promote employment in San José de Maipo and as part of the commitments made under the scope of the construction of Alto Maipo Project, AES Gener Foundation offers courses to develop the skills and abilities that will enable the inhabitants of the commune to take advantage of employment opportunities in those fields where there are special strengths at a local level.

During 2017, 11 courses were completed by 104 participants, including, without limitation, pastry chef, accounting assistant, national and international cuisine, domiciliary electrician, manual arc welding, basic accounting for microenterprise, basic English for tourism, design and manufacture of decorative items using the mosaic technique, gardening and maintenance of green areas, HR administrative assistant with SAP management, manufacturing of gastronomical and cocktail products for banquets and similar events.

DUAL EDUCATION

AES Gener Foundation contributes to the implementation of the Dual Students Program Ventanas and Angamos Plants and in the Guacolda Complex , in the communes of Puchuncaví, Mejillones and Huasco, respectively.

This program is intended to train competent professionals with practical experience in their area of specialization, as well as to contribute to the employability of young people. From the perspective of the company, it makes it possible to have a technical staff that is better prepared and adapted to the actual industrial conditions, in addition to generating a link between the company and the community under the scope of its business activities.

During 2017, the establishments that were part of the program were: Juan José Latorre Educational Complex of Mejillones, the Sargento Aldea Educational Complex of Puchuncaví and the General Velásquez School of Puchuncaví and the José Santos Ossa Secondary School of Vallenar. At the plants of AES Gener, students from the third and fourth year of technical secondary schools learn, in a practical way, those subjects they have theoretically learned in their educational establishments, including management, electronics and electricity. This year, students of the gastronomy career of General Velásquez School of Puchuncaví were included and completed their apprenticeship in the AES Gener Ventanas casino.

AES Gener, in addition to opening its doors to young people, provides them with travel allowance, food, safety features, and transport to further facilitate the practical conditions of this program.

AES POETA FOR YOUTH

During 2017, the AES POETA FIA (Fund for Self-Employment Initiatives), which aims to support self-employment and entrepreneurial initiatives. In this opportunity, 11 out of 18 young people belonging to the 2016 promotion participated and submitted projects related to their entrepreneurship.

The FIA chose 4 winners of the 18 projects presented and granted \$500,000 thousand pesos in order to strengthen their entrepreneurship and reward their business plans.

SCHOOL COMPLETION PROGRAM

As a result of the work performed with the Corporation of Education of San José de Maipo and the San Gabriel Bordering School, Alto Maipo and AES Gener Foundation have been developing since 2016 a school completion program for residents of San Gabriel.

During 2017, three students participated in the Primary School Completion Program, whose purpose is to develop a flexible teaching-learning process to enable the beneficiaries to complete their studies in that stage.

In turn, 21 students participated in the High School Completion Program, whose main purpose is to strengthen both their educational and social development with respect to the labor environment.

The program had a duration of 7 months and the classes were taught three times a week on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays from 4 pm to 7 pm. In addition, we must emphasize that classes were conducted at the school of the same town, thus allowing the students to attend the courses near their homes.

DIGITAL LITERACY

For the third consecutive year, the Digital Literacy Program was conducted at the computing room of the AES POETA for Youth Program, located in its home-office in San José SD Maipo.

In total, 74 students were distributed in three groups and, according to their learning interests, they were offered the opportunity to be included in the “Digital Literacy and e-Mail” and “Word and Excel user level” courses with a duration of two months each.

The purpose of the program was to help people who have no knowledge of the new technologies, so that they can have access to better tools and remain inserted in their community environments. As in the previous year, the coverage of this program was addressed to the community in general.

Another highlight in the development of the program during 2017 was the incorporation of 14 students from the Alto Maipo Business Strengthening Program, who have learned the contents of Word and Excel for two months. This initiative will allow them to gain knowledge in business development.

In three years, more than 234 students were benefited with this program.

SPORTS AND QUALITY OF LIFE

AES GENER FOUNDATION CUP

AES Gener Foundation and Ganamos Todos Foundation have been organizing since 2011 in Tocopilla the “AES Gener Foundation Cup”, whose purpose is to bring the benefits of physical activity to the prevention of sedentary life through the practice of sports, and to foster social values, such as team work, discipline and perseverance.

During 2017, the implementation of the program considered the creation of the AES Gener Foundation Cup School Futsal League.

This initiative encourages the participation of all the community through a football tournament made up of four series. The establishments that participated were:

The number of participants registered was 335 students in 32 teams of 9 educational establishments of the Commune.

As a pilot initiative, we conducted the “Jugamos Todos” program, which consists of a sport event held during breaks at Pedro Aguirre Cerda and Bernardo O’ Higgins Schools. Under this program, a monitor presents basketball, volleyball and tennis-football activities so that students may learn to play these sports in an organized and systematic manner.

We started developing the program in July 2017 in Pedro Aguirre Cerda School, with a monthly participation of 1,400 students, and in Bernardo O’ Higgins School with a monthly participation of 1,600 students.

Under the supervision of sport monitors, these breaks allowed the students to enjoy their leisure time in a healthy and amusing way with sports practices, thus significantly preventing sedentarism and school accidents, and strengthening the values and rules of the game.

“MASIFICANDO EL TENIS” (Expanding Tennis) PROGRAM

In coordination with the Tennis Academy of Horacio de la Peña, during 2017, the second edition of the “Masificando el Tenis” Program was conducted at the Commune of Huasco, which encourages the practice of this sport among children and young people of the commune.

Through this initiative, the participants have been part of the tennis clinics intended to reinforce the basic techniques of this sport.

During 2017, the program managed to conduct 32 clinics with the participation of approximately 1,600 students of the following educational establishments:

In addition, throughout the year, the Company conducted a workshop with an average of 20 participants. In this stage, monitors were able to put into practice the knowledge acquired in the training sessions.

The program was completed with the Interschool Tennis Tournament with the participation of all the schools in a recreational morning in the Costanera Amphitheater, where prizes were given to all students.

SUPPORT FOR AFTER-SCHOOL ACTIVITIES IN ANDES HIGH SCHOOL OF RENCA

During the year 2017, the alliance of cooperation entered into the Andes Polytechnic High School and AES Gener Foundation maintained the support to after-school activities developed for all the educational community made up of more than 1,300 students.

One of them is the Andes Polytechnic High School - AES Gener Cup Interschool Athletics Competition, which was conducted in the Recoleta stadium and gathered about 120 young people from the schools of the northwest sector of Santiago.

Under the scope of the cooperation alliance, the 10th Anniversary Run of the Andes DUOC-UC Secondary School of Renca in Parque de los Reyes was also conducted. Approximately 600 persons, including students, teachers, parents, and guardians, participated in the activity.

As part of a joint work with the educational community of the Andes Polytechnic High School, during 2017 the establishment opened its doors to conduct actions to the benefit of the neighbors of the sectors that are closer to the High School premises.

MECHANIC CHECK-UPS:

The initiative was developed by students of the Mechanics career, who carried out preventive mechanic check-ups for the neighbors of various commune boards of neighbors.

DIGITAL LITERACY WORKSHOP:

More than 40 neighbors participated in the workshop that addressed the basic aspects of computing. The initiative was carried out in the facilities of the establishment by the teaching staff.

COMMUNITY MANAGEMENT

SAN JOSÉ DE MAIPO COMPETITIVE FUND

Under the scope of the Alto Maipo project construction, AES Gener, the Municipality of San José de Maipo and the community represented by the Neighbors' Community Council, began a process of dialog that was recorded in the execution -in March 2009- of a Social Agreement that established the bases of two programs: Promotion of Local Employment and Social Program, made up of the Competitive Fund.

The latter is made up of San Jose de Maipo Competitive Fund, which will fund projects of social organizations and entrepreneurs for a total 5,807 development units (UF, for its acronym in Spanish) from 2012 and for 30 years.

By the end of 2016, we began with the nomination process for the fifth edition of the Fund, which was awarded to 67 winning projects, including social organizations and entrepreneurs.

One of the main modifications made during 2017 was the incorporation of contributions to the prominent athletes, as contained in scope 3 “Support to Sport in its Various Disciplines”, which became a new scope of individual application.

AES GENER PUCHUNCAVÍ COMPETITIVE FUND

The AES Gener Puchuncaví Competitive Fund is the result of a joint work between the Municipality of Puchuncaví and AES Gener, both of whom signed the regulations that form the bases for the program in 2014.

The term of the Fund is 10 years, during which it will contribute to the development of social organization projects of the commune for a total amount of 4,711 UF. During 2017, the Fund awarded 31 projects for a total \$122,331.484.

The AES Gener Puchuncaví Competitive Fund developed projects in 4 areas:

- Community-use infrastructure.
- Social Development and initiatives to promote tourism and culture at the commune.
- Promotion or development of productive or service activities that generate local employment.
- Support of initiatives to promote a healthy life.

PROCESS OF TRAINING IN “PREPARATION OF SOCIAL PROJECTS”

Trainings are a fundamental part of the process, allowing residents to equitably learn how to prepare projects.

The main objective of AES Gener Foundation is to be able to train the largest number of social organizations possible, and this is why the territorial deployment in this area reaches 11 locations of the Commune.

The evaluation of each project submitted is conducted by an external consultant and, according to those results, the winners are chosen and approved by the Board.

HUASCO COMPETITIVE FUND

As a result of a work with the Municipality of Huasco, during 2017, we began the first edition of the Huasco Competitive Fund, an initiative that aims at materializing the projects of social organizations of the commune through four areas of action:

Education and Training; Social, Touristic and Cultural Development; Community-Use Infrastructure; Support to Sport in its Various Disciplines; and for entrepreneurs, the scope of Promotion and Development of Productive Activities or Services that may reinforce Huasco in the areas for which it has special strengths.

Every year, the Company shall make available to the community 3,000 UF (79,991,670), which will be distributed among the projects awarded. These projects must be nominated and selected according to the provisions set forth in the bases.

The reception process of the first edition of 2017 Huasco Competitive Fund was closed with 90 projects presented (24 organizations and 66 entrepreneurs), who are waiting for the results that will be handed over to the Local Council by the external consultant responsible for the evaluation.

To coordinate the process of the Huasco Competitive Fund and allocate funding, the Local Council of Huasco, which is made up of 7 members, was created.

The members of this Local Council are:

- Governor of Huasco Province.
- Mayor of the Municipality of Huasco.
- Council Member appointed by the Municipal Council of Huasco.
- Chairman of the Neighbors' Community Council.
- Chairman of the Older Adults Community Council.
- Highest Authority of the AES Gener Guacolda Complex.
- Executive of AES Gener appointed by the company.

OTHER PROGRAMS

“ESCUELAS PARA EL DIÁLOGO” (SCHOOLS FOR DIALOG) PROGRAM

As part of a joint initiative with the Association of Generators of Chile, and the Ministry of Energy, a Pilot Plan was conducted in 2017 to carry out the program “Schools for Dialog”, an initiative developed by ComunidadMujer.

In the case of AES Gener, the program was conducted at the commune of Tocopilla jointly with Engie, and 30 neighbors were benefitted. The aim of the workshops was to provide specific tools to promote a better dialog on environmental and social matters, to contribute to the strengthening of trust relations and to work with companies in the energy sector.

CELEBRATION OF “NAVIDAD CON SENTIDO” (CHRISTMAS WITH SENSE)

As from 2013, the collaborators of Guacolda plant has been organizing a Christmas celebration with the neighbors of the neediest sectors of the city. In 2017, a total of 120 children arrived at the Cuatro Palomas Aquatic Park of Vallenar, to participate in a Christmas celebration, which included a foam party, swimming pools, Christmas show, inflatable games, balloon twisting, face painting, food and delivery of gifts and family boxes by Santa Claus.

This is an initiative of volunteer work created and organized by the workers, while funding is provided by the Company.

“PUERTAS ABIERTAS” (OPEN DOORS) PROGRAM

CONDUCT OF A PROGRAM OF VISITS OF THE COMMUNITY TO VENTANAS PLANT AND EL PANGUE

As in previous years, the neighbors of the commune of Puchuncaví were able to visit the plant and El Pangue Ecological Corridor as part of the Open Doors Program of the Company. As of this date, we have received 433 people, mainly social leaders and students.

The Guacolda Complex received a total of 138 persons between March and July 2017, including students from technical professional specialties, technical training centers and universities.

Meanwhile, Alfalfal plant, in the commune of San Jose de Maipo, received 321 persons during the year 2017 who learnt about the main features of power generation through a run-of-river plant. Moreover, the Maitenes nursery received 137 persons who learnt about the recovery of genetic material and reproduction of native plant species characteristic of the area.

"HUASCO DE PELÍCULA" CYCLES OF OUTDOOR CINEMA

During January and February 2017, in order to empower the neighbors on the use of public spaces, and also to offer an alternative of entertainment during the summer season, a new edition of the outdoor cinema cycle was developed in the communes where we operate.

A total of 9,600 neighbors and tourists were part of this activity, which was developed for the second consecutive time in: Tocopilla, Mejillones, Puchuncaví and San José de Maipo and for the ninth time in Huasco.

In addition, a musical show was held in each commune. In the case of Tocopilla, Mejillones and Huasco, a concert of Boleros, and in San José de Maipo and Puchuncaví, a presentation of the National Orchestra of Blind People together with Valentin Trujillo, and the play "Camilo y los mitos" were performed.

SUMMER SCHOOL

FLOR DE VERANO WITH ALTO MAIPO

Between January 3 and 27, 123 children participated in the Summer School “Flor de Verano with Alto Maipo”, an initiative that considered daily activities divided into 13 workshops given by lecturers specialized in leather, pastries, painting, circus, rock climbing, cycling, capoeira, afro-mix, and yoga, among others.

In addition, 4 field trips were included: MIM, Artequin, the Lonquén Educational Farm and Caja Los Andes Park, where they were accompanied by their respective workshop lecturers, monitors, and supervisors.

DENTAL CARE PROGRAM

The dental care program seeks to improve the oral health of students between 2nd and 8th grade of all municipal primary schools of the Commune of Huasco, the cities of Canto del Agua and Carrizal Bajo.

The Program covered 916 children between October 2014 and December 2017 through an assessment stage and subsequent recuperation treatments, including scaling, fillings, sealants, root canals, fluoride, x-rays, extractions and gingivectomy.

“SONRISAS” (SMILES) PROGRAM IN HUASCO

For the second consecutive year the “Smiles in Huasco” program was developed. This program seeks to promote a self-care culture to protect the oral health of children, with prevention activities and promotion of dental hygiene habits.

Developed by Fundación Sonrisas, during 2017, this initiative assisted 327 students from pre-kindergarten to second grade of the primary schools José Miguel Carrera and El Olivar. The methodology considers educational workshops where children learn how to maintain good oral hygiene, the influence of a smile in all aspects of life and brushing techniques to be practiced at home and at school.

During the year, 11 workshops were conducted in classrooms with proper tooth brushing dynamics, awareness of good hygiene, healthy eating subjects, measurement of oral hygiene index, where a total 459 children was examined.

The workshops were also addressed to teachers of the educational level and guardians of the students that participated in the program.

Between 2016 and 2017, 456 boys and girls were benefited.

TREE PLANTING IN THE VICTORIA DE RENCA COMMUNITY

In order to contribute to improve the tree planting conditions of various sectors of Renca, in 2017, AES Gener Foundation delivered 350 Genoa lemon trees (fruit and aromatic tree) for the neighbors of the Victoria community.

This allowed them to substantially improve the appearance of the landscapes through the recovery of flowerbeds and also to encourage community participation, and bring back neighborhood memories.

ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATION PROGRAM OF MEJILLONES AND TOCOPILLA SCHOOLS

Since 2016, the Company -through the *Sistema Nacional de Certificación Ambiental de Establecimientos Educativos* (National System of Environmental Certification of Educational Establishments, "SNCAE")- contributes to improve the quality of education for sustainability in establishments of Mejillones and Tocopilla, promoting environmentally responsible behaviors towards the environment where the educational project is developed.

The program is framed in five environmental axes: household solid waste, climate change, biodiversity, water and air.

In Tocopilla, three establishments have obtained excellence certification, two have obtained average certification, and one has obtained intermediate certification, with the participation of 2,202 students. In Mejillones, one establishment has obtained excellence certification, and another one has obtained basic certification, with the participation of 1,258 students.

In 2017, the plans developed by the participating schools were: efficient use of solar energy, efficient use of water, creation of nurseries or greenhouses, tree planting system, recycling, composting, among others.

As part of the program, certain clubs of environmental awareness builders, who must be leaders in their community oriented to education for sustainability, were created.

HUASCO FOOTBALL SCHOOL

Since 2010, Guacolda, in agreement with the Municipality of Huasco has been financing part of the Commune Football School, as a way of promoting sport and healthy living among children.

About 40 children are currently attending the school and participating in an educational and sport-oriented program, under which they take part in various competitions and massive events conducted by different sports institutions of the country.

In 2017, Guacolda delivered 20 balls and 40 football breastplates, prepared two competition teams, funded the participation of school members in national tournaments, and paid fees to their monitors.

WIFI NETWORK

From January 2015 to December 2020, the students and teachers of Japón High School of Huasco and El Olivar school of Huasco Bajo have access to free WIFI in their establishments. This is an initiative financed by Guacolda that seeks to collaborate in the digital literacy of the students, and to contribute to the culture and education of students.

CONTRIBUTIONS AND DONATIONS

TOCOPILLA SQUARE

As part of our program of contribution to the community infrastructure, AES Gener through the Nueva Tocopilla plant committed to build a public space to improve the appearance of the south entrance to the city. The site has an extension of 4,610 m² and is located in the area of access to Nueva Tocopilla plant of AES Gener.

The project was designed in a self-sustaining manner: the lighting system will be solar, and the irrigation water is recycled from the plant. Therefore, no municipal maintenance will be required.



COMMITMENTS MADE UNDER THE SCOPE OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALIFICATION RESOLUTION CONTAINED IN COCHRANE PLANT

As part of the construction of Cochrane Plant, located at the commune of Mejillones, the company committed various contributions under an Agreement executed with the Municipality of the commune and, by the end of 2017, 98% progress was made in the works contemplated in the agreement.

URBAN RECOVERY PROGRAM

During 2017, the second stage of the Urban Recovery Program was consolidated in Villa Illanes Beytia of Renca through the completion of the project of the "Nuestra Villa Hermosa" square, which included the improvement of the space adjacent to the multi-purpose sports field, a place which has fell into disuse and transformed into a rubbish dump.

The space was thought as an area for young people and skating practice, including a square with landscaped areas.

From the development of this program, the neighbours have been able to strengthen the neighborhood organizations in the sector and the community leadership. In addition to promoting the involvement and effective participation of neighbors in the local initiatives and spaces to make decisions about their neighborhood, it also made it possible to develop internal and external social articulation processes in the neighborhood.

CONSTRUCTION OF PUCHUNCAVÍ CESFAM

In the early days of 2018, we held the first stone ceremony for the construction of the Family Health Center of Puchuncaví (CESFAM). Under this initiative, the Company will contribute \$1,250 million to be allocated for the purchase of the land, the design of the project and part of the construction of the health center.

The total investment of the health center is \$2,642 million, 47% of which is contributed by AES Gener. The construction will have a duration of 14 months and is part of the Company's commitment to the development of public infrastructure and welfare of its neighbors.

LUISA SEBIRÉ DE COUSIÑO DE QUINTERO PARK

When AES Gener joined the public-private alliance that seeks to give a new face to the Luisa Sebiré de Cousiño de Quintero Park, its goal was to rebuild a public space, which will also be a green lung for the commune of Quintero.

In 2013, the engineering design project for Quintero Luisa Sebiré de Cousiño Park was executed, to which AES Gener contributed nearly \$100 million that financed the development of the design of architecture, landscape architecture and engineering for the remodeling of the park.

In 2017, the Company made a supplementary contribution to the construction of a pergola, gazebo, gateway and a secondary access to the project that was also funded by the Regional Government of Valparaiso and the Ministry of Environment. This Project will be inaugurated in the first half of year 2018.
